

Transvaginal Ultrasound information sheet:

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Transvaginal ultrasound is a routine form of gynaecological examination, used in ovulation induction, assisted reproduction, general gynaecology and early pregnancy management. You may require USS examination as part of your care at Women's Health Melbourne.

- The ultrasound transducer will be placed in the vagina (the probe is sterilised)
- The transducer will be introduced with a latex / non latex type covering. Please let us know if you are allergic to latex.
- It will be necessary to move the transducer from side to side, up and down and may be swivelled to obtain images
- If you prefer, you may insert the transducer yourself, otherwise the person conducting the examination will do this.
- A third person may be present during the examination acting as a chaperone, if required by the sonographer or sonographer
- You may request the examination to be stopped at any time during the examination Verbal consent will always be checked at every scan you have with us.
